STALLION SERVICE CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into on this day _____, 20____, by and between the following parties: Weber Quarter Horses, LLC Rick &/or Melissa Weber, Valentine, NE, hereinafter called "Stallion Owners" and _____ hereinafter called "mare owners" of (city/state) _____, _____, of (mare) _____ Registration # _____.

I HEREBY AGREE to breed said mare, and this mare only, using (circle one): cooled / frozen / shipped semen; or AI / live cover / pasture breed at _____ for the stallion, _____ for a non-refundable fee of \$ _____.
This fee to be made in full, payable to WEBER QUARTER HORSES, LLC, prior to service and/or shipment of semen.
BREEDING SEASON will be from _____.

SHIPPED SEMEN

Collection will be on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Requests for semen are to be made at least 24 hours before day of shipment. (See attached shipping info.) Shipment via Federal Express. *Saturday delivery is subject to location. Sunday delivery is not available.* The clinic or stallion owner will not be held liable for shipment issues due to inclement weather, and no guarantees will be made for shipped semen on any specific day.

ON-SITE BREEDINGS

Mare shall be healthy and in sound breeding condition, free from infection, contagious or transmissible disease. Attending veterinarian reserves the right to examine, test, and/or treat mare at mare owner's expense; and can refuse said mare if not in satisfactory condition. He will attempt with reasonable diligence to settle the mare. If however, the mare does not settle, veterinarian and/or stallion owner are to be held harmless.

Clinic agrees to provide suitable facilities for the care and feeding of the mare &/or foal while in their custody. All boarding and veterinarian costs, including arrangements and agreements as to care and expenses, are between Clinic and mare owner. Call Clinic prior to breeding time for a list of potential expenses and procedures.

Stallion owner, veterinarian, and any other parties involved shall be held harmless of liability for any loss from death, disease, sickness, injury, fire, theft, or other harm suffered by mare &/or foal, regardless of how it may occur. Likewise, mare owner shall not be liable for death, disease, sickness, or injury to stallion arising from services contracted for in this Agreement.

LIVE FOAL GUARANTEE

LIVE FOAL means that the foal resulting from the breeding stands and nurses without assistance and lives for 24 hours. If the mare fails to produce a live foal from the breeding privilege granted by this Agreement, the mare owner may rebreed the mare (or substitute a mare mutually agreed upon by both parties) during the subsequent breeding season. In the event of a substitution, a limit to only one designated mare in the subsequent breeding season will be allowed, a new contract must be completed, and a copy of the mare's registration papers attached. Any and all new costs incurred by the breeding clinic shall be the responsibility of the mare owner. This return breeding privilege is conditional upon the mare owner giving the stallion owner written notice within 7 days after foaling or aborting, that the mare did not produce a live foal. In the event the mare aborts, the mare owner shall certify to the stallion owner that the mare was accurately and properly administered vaccines to prevent the mare from aborting; such as rhinopneumonitis vaccines reflecting that the mare was administered an appropriate dosage of said vaccine on the fifth, seventh and ninth month of pregnancy. This notice must be accompanied by written certification from the attending veterinarian that no live foal was born. Should the mare be sold or otherwise disposed of prior to the birth of the foal, the Live Foal Guarantee granted shall be void.

TERMINATION

Prior to the breeding process, if the stallion dies, is sold, or becomes unfit for breeding in the opinion of the attending veterinarian designated for the breeding process, this Agreement will, at the option of the veterinarian, immediately terminate. The stallion breeding fee shall be refunded, and both parties will be released from any further obligation under this Agreement.

A copy of the mare's registration papers must be attached to this Agreement. The mare owner recorded on the registration papers will be recorded on the stallion breeding report. If the mare is leased, a copy of the lease from the mare's registry must be attached.
